Request items from any DCL library, and pick them up at any DCL library!

- Find a book, CD, or other item in our online catalog: <http://charlotte.delco.lib.pa.us/>
- Click the ✓Request button
- Enter your name and library card number (located below the barcode), then choose your pickup location from the dropdown menu
- Click the Submit button

When your item is ready for pickup, you will be notified by phone or email. (Choose or change your notification method under Modify Personal Information in My Record)

Can't find what you want in the DCL catalog? Try ILL!

Interlibrary Loan (ILL) allows patrons to borrow materials from libraries from outside the DCL system.

Who can use ILL?

Anyone with a current DCL library card that is free of fines. Patrons can borrow up to 4 ILLs at a time.

How do you place an ILL request?

Contact your local DCL library for assistance in locating and requesting materials outside of Delaware County. Your library will contact you when your item has arrived, or if there are issues with your request.

Does ILL cost anything?

Usually ILL is a free service. However, certain materials may only be available from libraries that charge \$10+ per ILL item. In these rare cases, you will be asked if you are willing to pay the ILL fee before the request is processed.

Overdue ILLs are assessed a \$.50/day late fee.

How long does ILL take?

Usually 7-14 days, though items occasionally may take 8-10 weeks or longer to arrive. If you decide you no longer want an item that you've requested, please notify your local library to cancel the request process.

ILL requests are not guarantees.

Some items may not be possible to obtain, including:

- New publications, like current bestsellers
- eBooks
- Antique/rare books
- Reference works, including genealogy materials

Please also note that ILLs are subject to the supplying libraries' policies, such as borrowing periods and renewals.
