### IMPORTANT:

- ⇒ You can stream magazines to your PC/Mac or mobile device to read the **Zinio for Libraries** selection of magazines when **online**.
- ⇒ The new **Zinio for Libraries app**, for reading magazines **offline**, is currently available for **iPad, iPhone, Android & Kindle HD/HDX devices**.
- ⇒ Note: The **Zinio for Libraries app** allows your to download a magazine to read offline. The **app** is free and available from your device's app store
