Library Opening for Public Browsing on Monday, April 5, 2021

The Haverford Township Free Library is pleased to announce our reopening on Monday, April 5, 2021. We welcome patrons back into the building after having served the community on a curbside-only basis for the past 3 ½ months. Our “Grab & Go” service will offer patrons the opportunity to enter the Library, choose materials and check out. For health and safety, patrons will notice several changes in our operations:

- Fifteen (15) patrons will be permitted in the building at a time; please wait at the front entrance for admittance.
- Patrons will be able to browse for up to 30 minutes. The convenient contactless pickup will still be available.
- The first hour of each day is reserved for seniors and those with compromised immune systems: Mon-Sat from 10am-11am.
- Printing/Faxing will be available with advance notice requested, please contact Reference at [reference@haverfordlibrary.org](mailto:reference@haverfordlibrary.org) or call 610-446-3082 x. 503.
- Museum Passes will be offered for check out depending on availability.
- All programs will continue virtually; no in-person programs will take place.

- Masks covering the nose and mouth must be worn at all times when in the library regardless of vaccine status. If you don't have one, the Library will happily provide you with one.
- To accommodate for social distancing please maintain a 6 ft. distance from one another.
- One person will be permitted in an aisle at a time.
- Computer use not available for first 2 weeks of reopening.
- Seating will not be available, as well as all meeting rooms will be closed.
- Book donations are *not* currently being accepted.
