

Dear Community:

As Covid-19 cases go down and with patron and staff safety our primary concern, the Library has been systematically and strategically expanding Library services for our community. The Library has:

- Added chairs for study and reading
- Returned newspapers to the shelves for reading
- Removed the limit on the maximum number of patrons that can be in the building at one time
- Begun taking book donations for the Friends of the Library book sale
- Hosting in-person programs in our local parks
- Reinstated our regular hours of operation
- Made more public access computers available
- Extended public access computer use to 2hrs daily per patron
- Made mask wearing optional for vaccinated persons on the first floor

We will continue to follow the CDC guidance, along with consulting with sources such as the PA Department of Health, the Office of Commonwealth Libraries and Township of Haverford, as we make further decisions that impact the operations of the Library in the coming weeks and months.
